Networked, digital tools will improve the food system but will also challenge our relationship to food in anxiety-provoking ways. Future food may be engineered, networked, and nearly independent of crops grown in fields. New technologies can make the food system more efficient—but at what cost to our traditionally close relationship with food?
